

PETER E. CROUCH, PhD

Dr. Peter E. Crouch, the newly appointed dean of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa's College of Engineering, arrives here following a distinguished career as administrator, educator, and scholar. Previously, Crouch served as vice provost for global engagement at Arizona State University and led the University's Ira A. Fulton School of Engineering. As dean for more than a decade, Crouch was responsible for elevating the school to one of the top 50 engineering programs in the nation, as ranked by US News and World Report. During his tenure, Crouch increased total graduate and undergraduate enrollment to 6,000 students, added 160 new faculty, established strong industry partnerships with some of the nation's largest high-tech companies, and developed educational programs in China, India, and Mexico. Prior to becoming dean at ASU, Crouch was chair of the university's electrical engineering department. He also enjoyed a successful teaching career in the mathematics and engineering departments of ASU for eight years. In addition, he taught for seven years at Warwick University in England. Crouch has authored 120 archival and refereed publications and two books. He holds BS (Engineering Science) and MS (Control Theory) degrees from Warwick University and a PhD in applied sciences from Harvard.

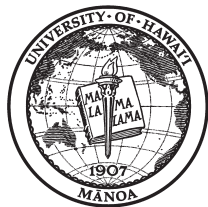
