## **EE 496 Poster Session**

### **Instructions:**

The EE 496 Poster Session showcases your senior capstone research project, with each project team presenting a poster of their work. Poster presentation is required for all projects, in partial fulfillment of the course's oral communication focus.

Choose your own poster style to effectively present your project. Example posters can be found online, from faculty, from other students, or the Powerpoint [template](#) on the EE website.

If your project is anticipated to be incomplete by the end of the semester (e.g. this is the first semester of a two-semester project), the title of your poster should be "WIP: Project Title". The "WIP" lets evaluators know that your results are work in progress and should be evaluated accordingly. Otherwise omit the WIP, e.g. "Project Title" to indicate that you are presenting final results.

The Department asks that you email the PowerPoint file of your poster to [eeasst@gmail.com](mailto:eeasst@gmail.com). If you do not plan on keeping your poster, the Department Chair requests that you leave it with him at the end of the poster session, so that it may be displayed on our hallway bulletin boards for future accreditation visits.

On the day of the presentation arrive 20 minutes early to setup your display. Easels, cardboard backing, and pushpins will be provided.

Read the evaluation rubric to get a general idea of the questions you will be asked. In particular, note that some of the outcomes evaluated are non-technical; be prepared to articulate how your project demonstrates these outcomes. All team members should be present and prepared to talk about your project and answer questions. Your poster will be evaluated by faculty and industry representatives. Your faculty advisor may take the quality of the poster presentation into account in your EE 496 grade.

- **Problem** addressed
- **Approach** used
- **Results** obtained
- **Ethical** considerations
- **Impact** (economic, societal, environmental, and global)
